Garbage Pick-Up

There has been some misunderstanding concerning the details of trash pick-up for the residents of the club. Our contract has always included the following:

- Weekly pick-up of up to 4 trash bags (normal containers)
- Cartons and boxes may be counted as bags. You will be charged for extra bags.

Any extra items that do not fit in a bag, such as furniture, or other large items call the club office before your pick-up day, so we can notify the hauler. They need a notice to plan proper pick-up. The club will be invoiced and then the club will bill you for the extra items.

* The club trash containers for the pool are not picked up during the winter months. They are used for the pool, not the residents.
