# **Clean-Up Jobs**

Because we didn't have a clean-up day this spring, there were many projects that didn't get done. It would be greatly appreciated if anyone wants to tackle any of the following tasks.

### At the Clubhouse:

- There are several limbs in the wooded area behind the Clubhouse that can be cut up and hauled to the burn pile in the playground.

- The club house rain gutters need cleaned out. We have a safety harness for whoever wants to go up on the roof and tackle this task.

#### At the Playground:

- The picnic tables need to be unstacked in both the large and small pavilion.

- The rain gutters of both the pavilions need to be cleaned out. This can be done using a tall stepladder.

- There are several large limbs in the wooded area behind the teeter-totters that need to be cut up and drug out to the burn pile.

- There are always sticks to be picked up and disposed of.

- Move the paddle boat out of the way close to the boat tie line and turn it upside down. We will NOT be putting the paddle boat in the water this year because we have no way to be sure that it gets disinfected after uses.

# Information on Off- road vehicles at Sevakeen Country Club

The By-Laws committee has reviewed the current rules for small vehicles, and recommended that changes in the rules were not needed.

Compliance with the current rules will solve any complaints. Please refer to section 5 of the current Ground Rules. They can be found on our website at <u>http://www.Sevakeen.com</u> under the "Members" tab. As stated in 5.3.1 "These rules are meant to apply to all forms of low speed recreational vehicles including golf carts, allterrain vehicles (ATV), dune buggies, snowmobiles, dirt bikes, and any other motorized land vehicle designed for recreational..."

Highlights of 5.3 include:

- All small vehicles must be registered with proof of liability insurance each year with the club.
- A driver's parent and/or the vehicle owner shall assume full responsibility for such operation.
- Small vehicles can only be driven on hard surfaced roads.
- The minimum age the driver is 12.
- Continuous circling or cruising is prohibited.

Please refer to Section 5 for all the rules. These rules were not put into place to limit recreation, but for the promotion of good neighbors and safety. Our goal is to keep Sevakeen a safe and friendly place to enjoy. As a note, State Law requires that all vehicles using a public road, Buck road, must be licensed and be operated by a licensed driver.
